General Information for Participants

Who is Liu Chang-I?

Grandmaster Liu Chang-I is the lineage head of the Liu Family Feeding Crane Kung Fu, from Taiwan. The system has been passed down unchanged in the Liu family, and contains a complete and traditional curriculum, including power development (kung li), forms, application, chi gung, body conditioning, as well as herbal medicine and other traditional practices.

Known to create incredible power from simple movements, Liu travels around the world to both demonstrate and teach others how to develop the ability to deliver the incredible kinetic power (Thunder) that is characteristic of Feeding Crane techniques.

Shifu has students all over the world including China, Canada, USA, France, Puerto Rico and more. He has been the subject of a Radio Television Hong Kong (RTHK) documentary, Kung Fu Quest TV show, a DVD series, books, and recently taught at a 3000 person seminar at Disneyland, California.

Shifu has been training in the martial arts for 42 years. His first visit to Wisconsin was in 2010 and he has returned once a year ever since to continue the advancement of his local students.
